






THE CHORUSLAB

The **COSTALAB ChorusLab** is a super-silent lush analog chorus based around two IMN3007 bucket-brigade chips. Designed for Guitar, but also perfect for Bass, the **ChorusLab** is a very versatile modulation pedal that nails the classic vintage chorus tone of the late 70s but covers also the full, rich, warm sounding tones of the 80s.



In the best Chorus tradition, you can also achieve Leslie-type tones playing with the rate knob. Unlike other analog products the **COSTALAB** adds a Blend (wet/dry) knob, to the classic Speed (Rate) and Depth. This helps you, even more, to sculpt the sound of your instrument, going from a subtle doubling effect to a full wet, immersive tone.

Run it at 12v for an even deeper 3D sounding effect.

The **ChorusLab**, like all the **COSTALAB** line-up, is fitted with True bypass switching and an anti-pop filter for transparent smooth operation.

SUPPLY

The circuit turns on by inserting a guitar cable into the Input jack of the pedal.

Battery: the pedal can be operated by a single **9 volt battery** (type MN1604) or with an external power supply. To install/replace the battery, simply remove the fixing screw of the battery compartment on the back of the stomp-box.

To preserve battery life, remove the cable from the input when you've finished using the pedal.

If you plug the pedal with an external power supply and don't use the battery for a long time, please consider removing the battery from the dock. **Battery is not included**.

External power supply: it is possible to power the pedal with an external center-negative 9volt DC power supply with standard 2,1mm DC connector. Current draw is less than 50mA. We suggest to use our filtered and stabilized **POWER FACTORY** power supply or an equivalent quality one. Using a different power supply may generate unwanted noise and may damage the product. When an external power supply is plugged, the battery is excluded.
